RESPONSE FROM AGRICORP

Agricorp has prioritized enhanced Production Insurance coverages for grain and oilseed farmers by providing separate coverage for oats and barley, a new plan for flax and mustard seed and currently working with the Ontario Seed Growers Association on separate coverage for pedigree seed coverage.

As part of the business planning process, Agricorp reviews input from industry including OSCIA and Grain Farmers of Ontario, OMAFRA and other industry groups to prioritize requests for future program coverage and will follow up to determine the priority of new coverage for additional grain crops such as fall rye.
