The Ontario Soil and Crop Improvement Association (OSCIA) is delivering this cost-share opportunity under the Sustainable Canadian Agricultural Partnership (Sustainable CAP). The Sustainable CAP is a five-year (2023-2028), \$3.5-billion investment by federal, provincial and territorial governments to strengthen competitiveness, innovation, and resiliency of Canada's agriculture, agri-food and agri-based products sector. This includes \$1 billion in federal programs and activities and a \$2.5 billion commitment that is cost-shared 60 per cent federally and 40 per cent provincially/territorially for programs that are designed and delivered by the provinces and territories.
