



## What Is a Knowledge Sharing Event (KSE)?

Ontario Soil and Crop Improvement Association (OSCIA) is delivering cost-share funding to support Knowledge Sharing Events (KSEs) that are delivered by agricultural organizations.

A KSE is an educational or networking opportunity that supports farmer learning and adoption of Beneficial Management Practices (BMPs) that are eligible under the Ontario On-Farm Climate Action Fund (OFCAF).

### Eligible formats include:

- Virtual webinars
- Workshops (in-person or virtual)
- Seminars
- On-farm demonstrations

### An event must include at least 30 minutes on one or more OFCAF BMP categories:

- Nitrogen management
- Cover cropping
- Rotational grazing



## Funding Details

KSEs must be delivered between February 2, 2026 and March 31, 2027, to be eligible for:

- **Up to 100% cost-share funding** for eligible KSE delivery costs to a maximum of \$10,000 per event
- **Up to \$50,000** available per organization (per program year)
